


## **Tianfu Square and Renmin Park**

Tianfu Square is the centre of Chengdu City, inside 1<sup>st</sup> Ring Road where the city is further spread out to 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3rd, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Ring Roads. The Cultural, Science and Technology Museums are located around this square with the status of Mao Zedong. Level 1 and Basement are shops cum restaurants with a food street selling Sichuanese small bites. A short ride will bring you to Renmin Park. The Heming Teahouse is 100 years old (built in 1923) and remain relatively unchanged. There are other tea houses dotted along the lake. During spring and autumn, beautiful flowers decorate the park with the golden gingko trees under the autumn sunlight. The local Sichuanese past time habits are playing mahjong, playing cards, sipping Chinese tea, getting their ears cleaned, line and social dancing throughout the day..

## <u>Bipenggou</u>

Chengdu is surrounded by high mountains and often you can view some Tibetan mountains from afar along the ride out. 1.5 to 2 hours bus ride into the natural mountain, lake and beautiful landscape. This trail is paved for cars and buses to bring you to the centre attraction. As young as 6 years old to as senior as 70 years old will be able to enjoy the leisure walk (with slight alleviation).



Probably a good idea to leave at 6am to catch these lovable pandas. Free entry for seniors 60 years and above on presentation of IDs. Park is big and probably will get a little tired after viewing panda natural habitat.

## Wenshu Yuan

The oldest and restored Buddhist temple which is a joy to devout Buddhists. Recommend a vegetarian buffet lunch since Chengdu grows their own vegetables and nut produces.
